Dear St. Rose Lions,

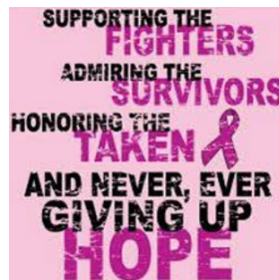
