Test begins at 8:00 AM; students should arrive by 7:45 and enter through Door #5 (Auditorium).

There is no pre-registration for this test.

There is a \$10 fee to cover the cost of the test; the student should bring this with them to the test (Cash or check payable to Roncalli High School).

Calculators are not allowed (Unless stated on an IEP/ISP).

Student should bring two #2 pencils.

Results will be mailed home by the end of November.

Parents are also strongly encouraged to attend an Admissions Information meeting on the morning of the HSPT from 10:00 – 11:15 AM in the Roncalli Auditorium.
