Canvas and Cookies:

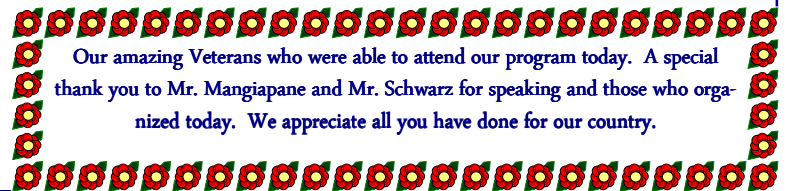
Please see the attached flyer to register your student(s) for our Canvas and Cookies event. Mrs. Owens will be planning the painting for the groups.

2019-20 Winter Jr. Lady Rebels Information

Registration for winter Jr. Rebels will be on **Saturday, November 23rd** from 1:00-2:30 PM for 4th and 5th Grades and from 2:45-4:15 for 6th, 7th and 8th players (who did not play in fall league) will need to be there to be evaluated. The participation for the Winter Indy Hoops League will cost \$60.00 if you need a jersey and \$50.00 if you do not need a jersey.

At least one parent will need to attend the sign-ups in order to make the payment, fill out paperwork and sign the IGHL release of liability form. Players will be evaluated on November 23rd and at the first two practices and then teams will be formed. Each team will practice once during the week and once on Saturday afternoon.
