Family Fun Night

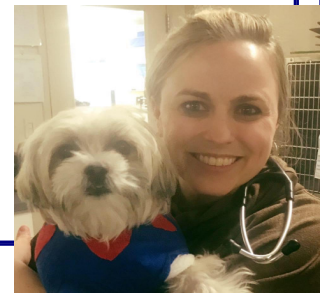

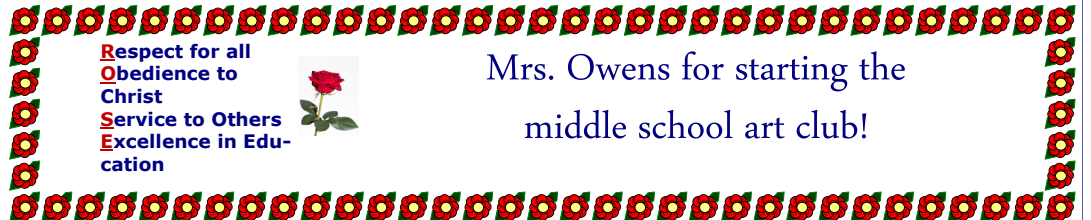

School Lunch Box

Exciting news from the Lions Cafe! Congress has allocated additional funding to USDA child nutrition programs to help families during the pandemic. **St. Rose will be offering school breakfast and lunch free of charge to all families beginning today, September**



14. The waiver for free meals will continue through December 31 or until the money runs out. Families will be notified if the waiver ends before December 31. All reimbursable meals are free for the duration of the program. A la carte purchases such as milk if lunch is brought from home and any "extras" will be charged to your child's lunch account. Qualify for an Education Expense Deduction - If you have a dependent child enrolled in K-12 private school or who is home-schooled, you may qualify for a deduction based on education expenditures for that child. Expenditures include tuition, fees, textbooks, and school supplies. If you are eligible, this deduction is \$1,000 per qualified dependent.
