After much discussion with other principals in the area, here is an update for guarantining after travel. From now until fall break, if you travel outside the state of Indiana, you need to quarantine for 5 school days. If you travel outside the state of Indiana for fall break or after, and you travel to a state at a higher risk than Indiana you need to quarantine for 5 school days. If you travel outside of Indiana to an area at or below the same risk level as Indiana, you need to monitor your activities and give serious thought to whether you should guarantine or if you took the necessary precautions to return to school.

We have several staff members that have compromised immune systems and we need to respect their needs. Please bear with me through all of this, as you know, things change on a regular basis and may again before Fall Break. I am trying to make decisions based on what I feel is best for all of us and to maintain all the precautions we have already put into place and seem to be working.
